## BEAR RESISTANT CONTAINERS

### INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

- Step 1** Position 2 handles on the top of the lid and mark where the holes are to be drilled.
- Step 2** Position the 3rd handle at the base of the drum and mark where the holes are to be drilled (bend the handle if necessary to fit around the curved drum).
- Step 3** Drill holes as marked. \* As a safety precaution drill additional holes into the lid and base of the drum. DO NOT allow children to play with or climb inside the drum.
- Step 4** Attach handles using the hardware provided (3 galvanized steel handles, 6 bolts, 6 screws, 6 flat washers).

If you are assembling multiple cans at once you may want to try a production line and assign each worker a task. For example:

- Worker #1 unwraps the hardware and bends the bottom handle so it fits around the drum;
- Worker #2 marks lids for drill holes; Worker #3 marks drums for drill holes;
- Worker #4 drills holes in lids; Worker #5 drills holes in drums; Worker #6 assembles handles on lids;
- Worker #7 attaches handles on drums;
- Worker #8 tightens all lock nuts and handles; Worker #9 stacks all the drums and lids.



### USAGE INSTRUCTIONS

- Step 1** Indicate to the garbage collector that this lid has a screw-top by drawing an arrow to the left and indicate the direction to turn.
- Step 2** Loosen the lid slightly on the day of garbage collection
- \*NOTE\*** Bears may try and drag your can off to a location where they can try and open it privately. To deter their efforts you may want to secure your can to a large tree or post with a chain. Periodically rinse your can out with bleach.
